Military Operation Report

Date of operation: Storms 3 - Storms 5

Jessica woke myself and Lieutenants Marley, Anton and Marcellus individually in the pre-dawn hours of Storms 3.

She informed us that she was in possession of urgent intel that required an immediate response.

I questioned her further and she disclosed that one her of spies in Tarrant had reported the possible existence of a Tarrant Battleborne in a small village. This possible Battleborne is a civilian and unknown to the Tarrant military. We were to extract, if possible, this individual to prevent Tarrant from exploiting the asset.

Lt. Jessica had already acquired gear from the Quartermaster for our sortie as well as a small fishing vessel to ferry us across.

Jessica expected the mission to take 2 days.

This vessel belonged to a civilian and was not Caydn military.

The next day we met Fizz in the morning. Fizz tells us he works as a messenger between towns for the Tarrant Kingdom. He does not live in this particular town. About a week ago he saw blue light coming from a house He only saw it once and only one color

At this point I further expressed my concern regarding this information. And detailed a few, non-magical, ways that a blue light could be created. I told Jessica that a single blue light coming from a farmhouse seems too innocuous to require this kind of response.

Fizz also provide a description of the village and where we can find the house in question. He also mentioned a bridge and how it could be used as an ambush point. We then made our way to the village. Fizz did not accompany.

Jessica was scouting ahead as usual.

Upon crossing the bridge she was set upon by 5 Tarrant soldiers lying in wait. The bridge had been sabotaged and was destroyed.

Effectively separating Jessica from the rest of us

The bridge spanned a fast moving, rocky river.

15 feet down and 20 feet across.

We attempted to engage in the enemy and rescue Jessica from this trap.

Jessica fell quickly under a hail of arrows.

Myself and Marcellus were able to make the 20 foot leap across the chasm to engage the enemy.

Marley attempted the leap across but plunged into the river instead.

Jessica's body was dragged away by 3 more Tarrant soldiers that entered the battle.

I was able to dispatch the five remaining Tarrant soldiers as Marley climbed his way out of the ravine.
